We currently hiring geological oceanographers to help with the monitoring and examining the seabed, including the rocks in every section of Mount Vema during construction of the [City of Mount Vema](#).

We are offering contracts of up to 10 years to experienced geological oceanographers, who will be involved in all aspects of the construction of the city of Mount Vema with a variety of tasks and responsibilities including lab and office-based work, which will involve computer modelling, and work onboard of a research vessel, gathering data from subsurface instruments.

You will be required to plan and carry out research expeditions, collect samples and data from the sea floor using specialised equipment and techniques, analyse samples for natural and contaminant composition, use statistical models of laboratory and field data to investigate hypotheses and make predictions.

We are offering salaries ranging from 18,000 to 25,000 golles ([Mount Vema currency](#)) depending on your qualifications and experience and could progress to a salary of 35,000 to 45,000 golles with substantial experience.

Working hours

Working hours vary. Hours at sea are less regular. Time at sea can vary from days to months. Extra hours may be required to meet deadlines and may include weekend and shift work.

What to expect

You may spend a lot of time working in a lab or office or at home using computer modelling systems. However, you'll also spend time away at sea on a research vessel in Mount Vema, sampling and gathering data from instruments far below the surface. You need to be comfortable using diving equipment and submersible vehicles to deploy and recover instruments.

Conditions at sea may be hazardous and physically demanding, with cramped accommodation and difficult weather conditions. Adjusting to periods away at

sea and working long hours may be challenging. However, most oceanographers view time at sea as an essential and rewarding part of the work.

Before submitting your CV, please be aware that all vacancies to work in Mount Vema, require a [Mount Vema bank account](#), and a work visa. You need to find out first if you are eligible to work in Mount Vema. To do this, you need to apply for an [Entry Visa](#) suitable for this type of job vacancy.
